### **By Bike**

Elwood is quiet and there are lots of bike paths – I encourage people to ride (I will have at least one bike available there for people who wish to have a ride up the bike path during the day)

Northsiders coming through the city should head up St Kilda Road then weave through the mess of St Kilda Junction onto Fitzroy Street. At the end of Fitzroy Street you hit the water and take the scenic bike path right to the front door of Elwood Sailing Club. (See [map](#))

Paid parking is available at the venue – free parking in the surrounding streets.

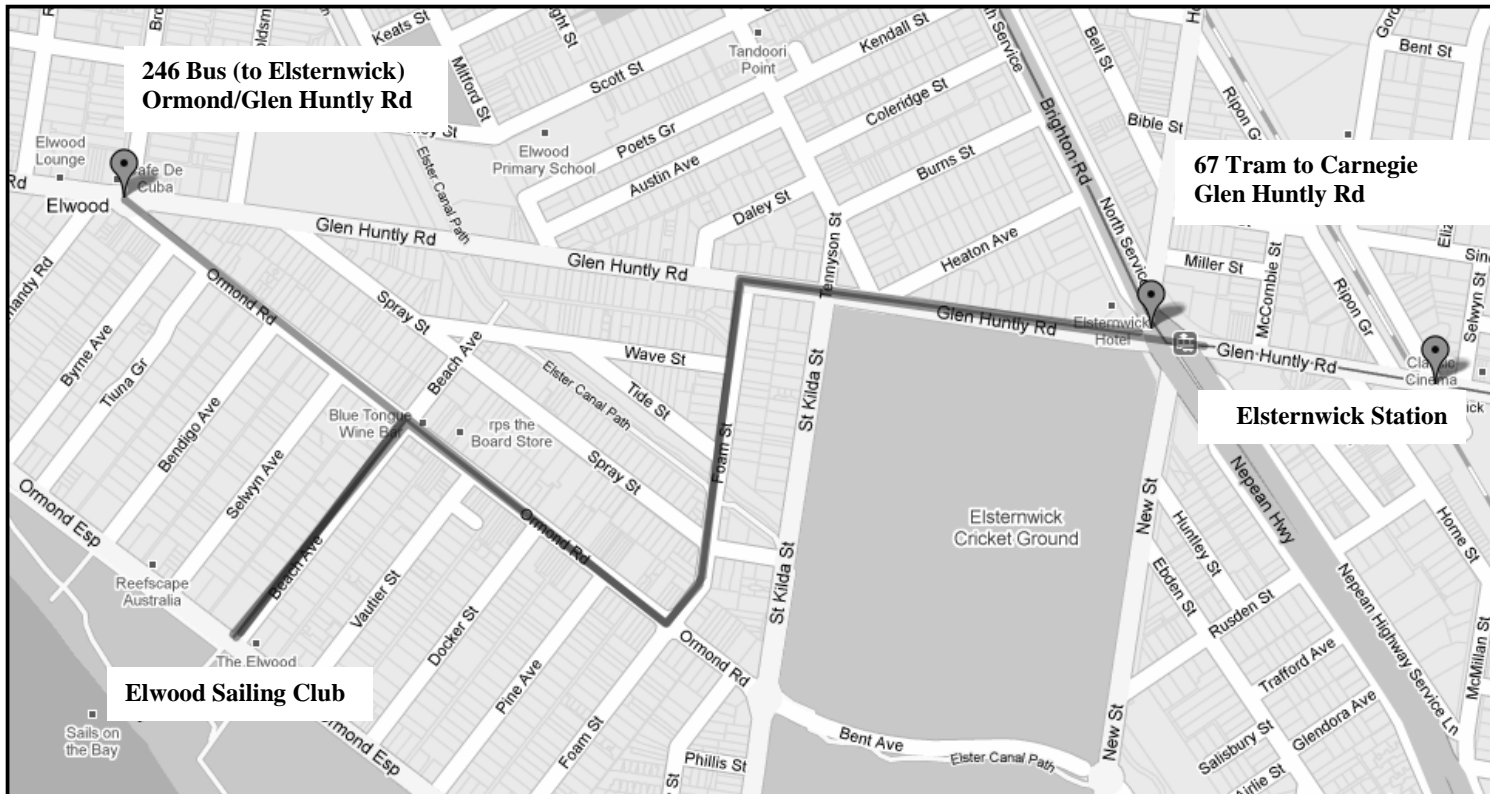
### **Public Transport**

Train Sandringham Line – Elsternwick Station (14 mins from city)  
2 km walk from Elsternwick Station (approx time: 20 mins) (see [map](#))

Tram 67 Carnegie – to corner of Brighton Road and Glenhuntly Road (29 mins from city)  
1.5 km walk from Brighton Road and Glenhuntly Road (approx time: 15 mins) (see [map](#))

246 Bus (Elsternwick) from Richmond Station to Ormond Rd/Glen Huntly Rd (Elwood:Stop ID: 901) - Bus stop (20 mins from Richmond) - Runs every 10 mins (it comes from 'Northside' if you want to catch it somewhere other than Richmond here is the route [map](#))  
800m walk from Ormond Rd/Glen Huntly Rd (approx time: 10 mins) (see [map](#))
